Platanthera aquilonis	Northern green bog orchid	early July to early August	frequent
Platanthera huronensis	Tall Northern Green Orchid	early July to early August	common
Platanthera obtusata	Blunt-leaved rein orchid	early July to early August	common
Spiranthes romanzoffiana	Hooded ladies'tresses	mid July to early August	common

## \*\* Occurrence

Common: expect to find this in most places within an area - don't have to look to hard to find it.

Frequent: expect to find it in most places within the area - but you will have to look to find it.

Occasional: scattered throughout the area - but not in any numbers - you may have to know the preferred habitat

to find it.

Rare: expect to spend a substantial amount of time in preferred habitat to find this one.

Very rare: lady luck will have to be with you on this - even in the preferred habitat.
