Orchids of the Grand Rapids Area

(includes a 50km radius from the town of Grand Rapids)

<i>Amerorchis rotundifolia</i>	Small round leaved bog orchid	mid June to mid July	common in localized areas
<i>Calypso bulbosa</i>	Eastern fairy-slipper	late May to early June	common
<i>Coeloglossum viride</i> var. <i>virescens</i>	Long bracted green orchid	late May to mid June	frequent
<i>Corallorhiza maculata</i> var. <i>maculata</i>	Spotted coralroot	late June to mid July	occasional
<i>Corallorhiza striata</i>	Striped coralroot	late May to mid June	rare
<i>Corallorhiza trifida</i>	Early coralroot	late May to early June	frequent in localized areas
<i>Cypripedium arietinum</i>	Ram's-head lady's-slipper	through June	occasional to frequent in localized areas
<i>Cypripedium parviflorum</i> var. <i>pubescens</i>	Large yellow lady's-slipper	early June to mid July	common
<i>Cypripedium parviflorum</i> var. <i>makasin</i>	Northern small yellow lady's-slipper	late May to mid June	common
<i>Cypripedium reginae</i>	Showy lady's-slipper	late June to mid July	frequent in localized areas
<i>Goodyera repens</i>	Lesser rattlesnake orchid	early July to early August	common
<i>Liparis loeselii</i>	Loesel's twayblade	through July	occasional
<i>Listera cordata</i>	Heart-leaved twayblade	late June to mid July	occasional in localized areas
<i>Malaxis brachypoda</i>	White adder's-mouth	through July	rare
<i>Platanthera aquilonis</i>	Northern green bog orchid	through July	common
<i>Platanthera dilatata</i> var. <i>dilatata</i>	Tall white northern bog orchid	through July	occasional
<i>Platanthera huronensis</i>	Green bog orchid	through July	common
<i>Platanthera obtusata</i>	Blunt-leaved rein orchid	through July	common in localized areas
<i>Platanthera orbiculata</i>	Pad-leaved orchid	through July	occasional
<i>Spiranthes romanzoffiana</i>	Hooded ladies'-tresses	mid July to early August	frequent

** Occurrence

Common: expect to find this in most places within an area - don't have to look too hard to find it.

Frequent: expect to find it in most places within the area - but you will have to look to find it.

Occasional: scattered throughout the area - but not in any numbers - you may have to know the preferred habitat to find it.

Rare: expect to spend a substantial amount of time in preferred habitat to find this one.

Very rare: lady luck will have to be with you on this - even in the preferred habitat.
